



Nearly 300 Million Elderly

According to the latest census, China's population aged over 60 has increasing by 5.4% since 2010, reaching 264 million in 2020, or 18.7% of the entire population. Of these, over 190 million people in China are aged 65 and over, 13.5% of the population, which will double to surpass 380 million by 2050.

Rising Purchasing Power

People born in the 1960s have started to reach retirement age from 2020. China's own Boomer Generation has a higher education level and was the first to benefit from China's opening up. They care about their quality of life in retirement, and over the next 20 years will have increasing purchasing power to meet their needs in old age, corresponding to China's rise in affluence.


